Reminders for Parents!



It is the season for snowy and cold days and nights. Whenever the two mixes there is always the possibility of changes to our school day. Always listen to the local stations or tune in to Channel 13 to learn about school cancellations or delays. Please remember:

- Dress your child warmly. If an emergency situation would happen where we would need to be outside, your child would need a hat, gloves, and a coat. Remember to send them to school with warm clothing.
- The bell rings at 7:15 a.m. Drop your child off as close to 7:15 as you possibly can. It is too cold to be waiting outside for the building to open.
- We need current telephone numbers. If you have changed your number recently please inform your child's teacher or contact the school. If we make it to school and an early dismissal is called, we need to be able to get in contact with you concerning transportation. Your child will have to remain at school if we are not able to contact you. Please send updated telephone numbers.
- Email notices are accepted if there is an early dismissal. Email your child's teacher, Mrs. Anestis, or Mrs. Collins to let us know how you want your child to get home. This is only for early dismissal when we are dismissing due to inclement weather. The email should include the child's name, homeroom teacher's name, and a description of how the child was dressed when they left home that morning.
